This position is established on the Western & Central Oregon Lands Zone, which provides boundary management, land adjustments, and rights-of-way services to seven client National Forests in Oregon, the Siuslaw, Willamette, Umpqua, Rogue River-Siskiyou, on the westside of the Cascade Mountains and the Fremont-Winema, Deschutes, and Ochoco National Forests and the Crooked River National Grassland east of the Cascades. The Zone is staffed by 14 employees located in various locations in Oregon. This position is located in the Zone's Westside Boundary program and reports to the Westside Boundary Lead. The Westside Boundary organization serves the Siuslaw, Willamette, Umpqua, and Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forests.
