Clinical Internship. 3 credits, 3 contact hours (3;0;0).

By Advisement; Consists of 100 hours of experience in the clinical engineering department of a hospital. The student is under the supervision, and is evaluated by, the director of clinical engineering at the hospital. A final report is submitted to and graded by the NJIT faculty advisor.

Course Details:

- EHR security
- Patient portals etc.
